

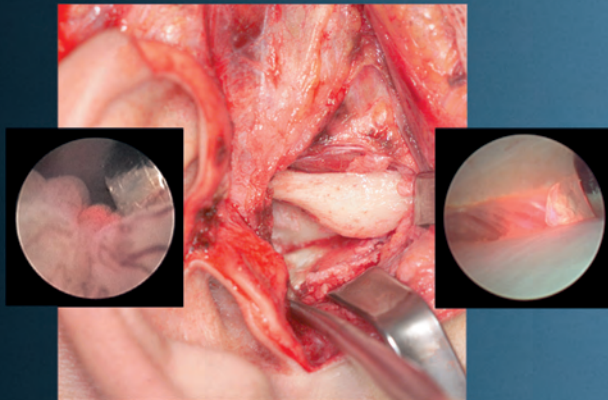

Each group is limited to a maximum of 16 participants. The fees are based on **two attendees per video-arthroscopy unit and per fresh human cadaveric specimen (one joint for each participant)**. As the number of cadaveric specimens is limited, attendees will be selected on a first registered, first accepted basis.

Biological hazard

Since this course includes dissection on fresh cadavers, the risk of injuries and/or infections cannot be totally excluded. Therefore participants have to check that their compulsory vaccinations are in order and that their insurance company will take in charge the possible injuries and complications that may occur during the workshops.

In order to relieve the course organizers of any responsibility, participants are asked to sign the certificate and disclaimer at the registration desk upon arrival.

Usual protections (masks, surgical gloves, coats, caps) will be provided. However, protection glasses will not be provided and participants are invited to bring their own ones.

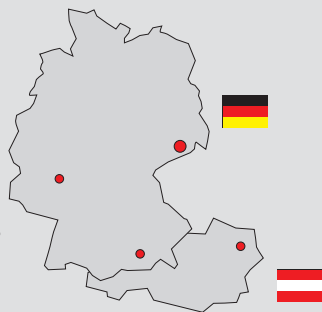
Transfer Dresden/Vienna

Vienna is the capital city of Austria with full access to all major airports, railway and motorway connections.

By air: Dresden and Vienna have a flight connection usually with stop-over Munich, Frankfurt or Düsseldorf.
