

The Atomium Course

A Brussels continuation of the Bruges Lobster course

- The Lobster Course from year 2003 to 2010
- Surgeries included 114 BSSO's, 2 USSO's, 72 Le Fort I-osteotomies (single or multiple segments), 31 chin-osteotomies, 24 TPD's, 1 SARME, 7 malar valgisation osteotomies, 2 TMD's, 4 protruding ears, 3 rhinoplasties, 2 submental liposuctions and 3 craniofacial cases (Le Fort III, adult scaphocephaly, orbital dystopia). This is 265 procedures (BSSO's counting as 1). In 2005 we stopped operating on Friday's, because of the exhaustiveness of the surgeries, theoretical sessions, and social programme. This means an average of 9,3 procedures per day over 35 operating days.

- Surgeries included 4 BSSO's, 4 Le Fort I-osteotomies, 2 chin-osteotomies, 1 rhinoplasty. There were 2 hemifacial microsomia cases.
