FLAPS COVERED:


PEDICLED: Pectoralis Major, Delto Pectoral, Trapezius.

FREE FLAPS:

Radial forearm- soft tissue/composite, Lateral Arm, Lattismus dorsi, Scapula,
Parascapula System- Soft tissue/ Composite, Anterolateral Thigh, Gracilis, Rectus
Abdominis, Fibula, DCIA.
