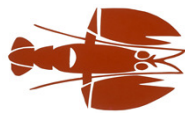

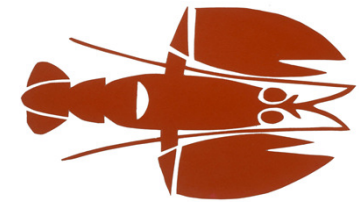

The Bruges 3D Orthognathic Surgery Course “The Lobster Course”

Attendance is limited to 12 EACMFS trainee-members only. A certificate confirming trainee membership, which can be obtained from the EACMFS Secretariat (secretariat@eacmfs.org), is a prerequisite.

The programme includes active participation in surgery in the operating theatres, instructional lectures on prediction planning (tracing: pencil method and simulation software) and mock-surgery, and lectures on surgical strategies. Participants will be exposed to 25 orthognathic surgical procedures in 4 days.
