

AOCMF Symposium—Pediatric Craniomaxillofacial Surgery. An Update

August, 25-26, 2016 Bremerhaven, Germany



This symposium is mainly composed of lectures and panel discussions about the various aspects of treatment and management of pediatric patients with congenital deformities, trauma as well as tumors of the craniomaxillofacial region. Strong emphasis will be given to the interdisciplinary management of this patient group. The second day will start with a hands-on-workshop on 3D-planning and navigation-assisted surgery. Based on selected cases the current workflow of the virtual planning process and intraoperative navigation will be demonstrated.

Target audience

Fully qualified surgeons (maxillofacial surgeons, head and neck surgeons, plastic surgeons, pediatric surgeons, pediatric neurosurgeons) involved in management and surgical treatment of pediatric patients with congenital deformities, trauma, benign and malignant tumors of the craniomaxillofacial region. Participants should have basic knowledge in pediatric CMF surgery.
