Symposium description

This AOCMF Research and Development Scientific Symposium supports clinical decision-making and enables knowledge transfer from research to clinical practice in ENT, maxillofacial, and plastic surgery. Eleven worldwide, leading CMF experts will be in Helsinki to provide a unique combination of thorough clinical experience and scientific, peer-reviewed data. At the end of the symposium, the AO Program for Education and Excellence in Research (AOPEER) will launch. This web-based platform provides resources, reference documents, and learning opportunities for health care professionals who want to learn or improve the skills they need to conduct clinical research.

At the symposium, four complex surgery cases will be discussed by highly experienced CMF surgeons:

- Mandible Reconstruction Using Bone Substitute Material
- Trauma Orbital Fractures
- Trauma Condylar Fractures
- Planning of Orthognathic Surgery (CAD and Navigation)

The discussions are highlighted by a literature review.

AOCMF Research and Development invites and encourages participants to submit their own complex cases on the chosen topics by March 31, 2017. The most valuable and controversial cases will be chosen for the literature review and live discussion.
