This 2 Module hands on cadaveric course uses Genelyn Cadavers with 2 delegates per cadaver along with supervision from an expert consultant faculty, in a simulated environment. Both modules are open to trainees and newly appointed consultants in OMFS, ENT and Plastic surgery.



Module I: Resectional Tactics in Head and Neck Surgery

This two day course provides the underpinning knowledge base and practical instruction in resection techniques on head and neck surgery.

Highlights include:

Day 1

- Imaging of oral cavity, oropharynx, and maxillary sinus cancer
- floor of mouth cancer
- Neck dissection and floor of mouth resection
- tongue cancer
- retromolar trigone/ anterior pillar of tonsil
- mandibular segmental resection / rim resection / visor drop down

Day 2

- Weber Ferguson Diffenbach and anterolateral corridor approach to the infratemporal fossa
- Extended radical maxillectomy
- Through defect skull base resection
- Laryngectomy
- Pectoralis Major Pedicled flap in laryngeal reconstruction

Module II: Head and Neck Reconstruction

This three day course provides the knowledge base and practical instruction for raising commonly used free flaps as well as providing instruction for their use in head and neck reconstruction **including an opportunity to plan and carry out 3D custom made guided surgery.**

Highlights include:

Day 1

- Pectoralis Major and Delto Pectoral
- Radial Forearm Free Flap
- Rectus Abdominus Free Flap
- Tongue and Floor of Mouth Reconstruction

Day 2

- Fibula Free Flap
- Gracillis Free Flap
- Anterolateral Thigh Free Flap
- Mandibular Reconstruction
- Post Laryngectomy Reconstruction using Free Tissue Transfer
- Supracalvicular Flap

Day 3

- Latismus Dorsi Free Flap and Scapula Free Flap
- DCIA Free Flap
- Maxillary Reconstruction
- Lateral Arm Free Flap
- MSAP Free Flap
- Custom Made Mandible Reconstruction *
