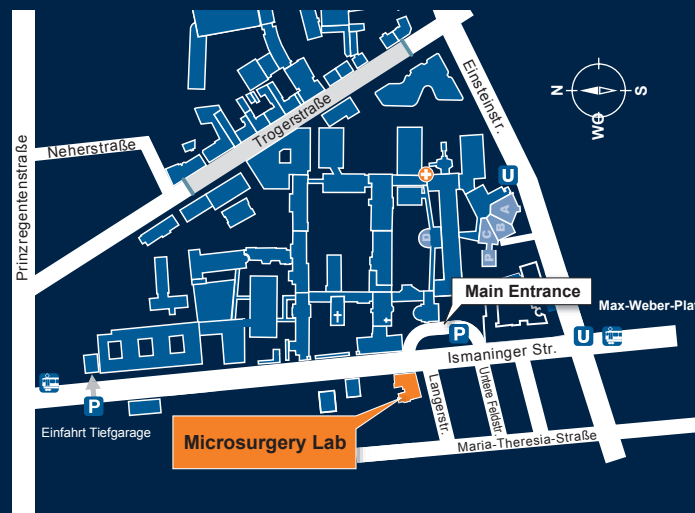

- Practice** Chicken leg femoral nerve

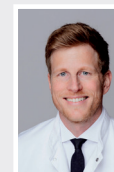

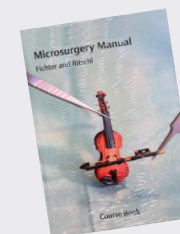
