AOCMF Lighthouse Course—Reconstructive Surgery in Head and Neck with Flap Harvesting and Patient Specific Implants (with Human Anatomical Specimens)

September 10–11, 2019 Madrid, Spain

COURSE DESCRIPTION This two-day course is a hands-on human anatomical specimen event encompassing state of the art reconstructive techniques using a variety of free and pedicled flaps in the head and neck. Panel discussions and interactive debates around controversial topics will be used in an open forum that is evidence based and will be live-streamed.

The expert faculty will share their tips and tricks in dealing with complications and salvage surgery. Participants will practice computer assisted planning for resection, reconstruction and the use of patient specific implants in real-time.

Two participants will share one-half of a human anatomical specimen for flap harvesting and one laptop for computer planning.

TARGET PARTICIPANTS The course is aimed at experienced trainees, early career surgeons and experienced surgeons in oral maxillofacial, plastics or ENT.

COURSE OBJECTIVES After the course, participants should be able to:

- Accurately predict the defect
- Choose the optimal reconstruction
- Decide if surgery is appropriate
- Virtually plan the resection and the reconstruction
- Perform a variety of reconstructive techniques
- Deal with complications and pitfalls
