We invite you to take part in the National Congress with international participating “Lecturings for the Parin’s name 2020. Topical issues of diagnosis, treatment and clinical examination of patients with surgical pathology cranio-maxillofacial area and neck” to be held in Minsk on May, 7-8, 2020

- 9) *new research in neurostomatology;*
- 10) *traumatology cranio-maxillo-facial region;*
- 11) *emergency conditions in maxillofacial surgery and surgical dentistry;*
- 12) *issues of medical examination of dental patients.*

Requirements for articles.

Dear colleagues!

Please note that only the articles on maxillofacial surgery and surgical dentistry will be published !!!

- *forum languages: Russian, English;*
- *the total amount of materials for publication is 5 pages of computer text typed in the WORD editor version not lower than 2007, of which:*
 - 1) *the actual article of 5 to 7 pages (includes text, black and white photos, graphics, diagrams-no more than 1 (one)), printed at 1.5 intervals font Times New Roman. Fourteen;*
 - 2) *the article should be accompanied by information about the authors*
(INFORMATION FOR OBLIGATORY PROVIDING!):

1. INFORMATION ABOUT THE AUTHORS

- *full name of all authors (in Russian and English);*
- *full name of the organization – place of work of each author in the nominative case, country, city (in Russian and English). If all authors of the article work in the same institution, you can not specify the place of work of each author separately;*
- *email address for each author;*
- *correspondent postal address and phone number for contacts with the authors of the article (you can one for all authors).*

OPTIONAL:

- *subdivision of organization;*
- *position, rank, academic degree;*
- *other information about the authors.*

2. ARTICLE TITLE

In Russian and English.

3. ABSTRACT

The article in Russian and English. Annotations should be 1500 characters with spaces and be structured, contain: introduction, purpose, objects and methods, results, conclusion.

4. KEYWORD

Keywords or phrases are separated from each other by semicolons. Keywords in Russian and English.

5. SUBJECT HEADING (CODE) (valid for CIS countries only)

MANDATORY-code UDC and / or GPNTI and / or code VAK (according to the current nomenclature of specialties of scientists).

OPTIONAL-other library and bibliographic subject classification indexes.

6. LIST OF REFERENCES

References and / or lists of references should be made in accordance with GOST 7.05-2008. Bibliographic reference. General requirements and rules of compilation (see link.... Annex 2).

- 3) *page layout (margins): left-26 mm, right-29 mm, top-26 mm, bottom-34 mm, paragraph indentation-1.25 cm, **without hyphen**;*
- 4) *the work should be structured and contain: introduction; purpose of the work; objects and methods; results; conclusion; list of references not more than 5 (five) titles;*
- 5) *articles are provided only in electronic form (in a WORD file); in a separate WORD file – addresses and contact numbers of authors;*
- 6) *pages with the visa of the head "in the press", the last page of article with signatures of authors, are applied in separate files in the format .PDF;*
- 7) ***one author can publish only one work (alone or in co-authorship);***
- 8) *the electronic version is sent to the E-mail attached file named by the name of the first author with the extension .docx;*
- 9) ***materials should be provided from 01 November 2019 until February 01, 2020 only by e-mail: parins.lectures@gmail.com***

ARTICLES SUBMITTED in VIOLATION of the REQUIREMENTS, WITHOUT a STRUCTURED ABSTRACT in ENGLISH, submitted later than the specified period will not be considered. The organizing Committee reserves the right to select and edit the materials submitted for publication. Rejected works are not returned to the authors.

Rules for submission of applications for reports and requirements to design electronic posters

The application for oral presentation is submitted in electronic **form from 01 November 2019 to 01 February 2020 by e-mail: parins.lectures@gmail.com**. the application must indicate the title of the report, the author (s) (listing all co-authors and organizations they represent), the author who makes the report must be italicized, the time required for the presentation of the report, oral or poster report.

Poster presentation is made in PowerPoint format (no more than 5 slides). Slides are not numbered, animation is not displayed. The first slide is the title slide. The file should be named after the first author.
