Course description This three-day course is a hands-on event with human anatomical specimens, taking place in the institution where modern teaching of human anatomy started centuries ago. This event covers most relevant and modern surgical approaches and techniques in facial surgery. Panel discussion and interactive debates on controversial topics will be used in an open forum that is evidence based. The expert faculty will share tips and tricks in dealing with standard procedures and complications. Two participants will share one human anatomical specimen, for surgical approaches and operative techniques.

- Select the correct approach
- Perform the approach correctly and airway management
