

AEAC two-day facelift course on human anatomical specimens - May 14 and 15, 2020

Gent, Belgium

Goal of the course

The course covers the current concepts and techniques of cervicofacial rhytidectomy with the aim of achieving full restoration and rejuvenation of the face and neck. Surgical exposures will be performed on anatomical specimens.

Target participants

Specialists with a focus on the face and interested in advancing their expertise in midface and cervicofacial rejuvenation.

Participants must be willing to share their ideas and be able to communicate well in English.

Course description

Concise and comprehensive lectures and interactive cadaver sessions promote exchange between participants and faculty members. At the anatomical specimen laboratory participants apply different techniques and approaches (2 participants per specimen). Ample opportunities are provided to share experience with peers and the expert international faculty.
