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ADDRESSED TO:

The course is intended for professionals involved in the treatment of patients with Cleft Lip and Palate (CLP). Specialists in Maxillofacial Surgery, Plastic Surgery, Otolaryngology, Pediatric Surgery, Odontology (Odontopediatrics – Orthodontics – Prosthodontics) and Speech Therapy are invited to apply.

COURSE AIMS:

Provide the required knowledge to prevent, diagnose and establish a treatment plan for pacients with CLP and Velopharyngeal Dysfunction (VPD).

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

A 3-day course that will provide keys for a interdisciplinary approach to prevent, diagnosed and treat VPD in patients with cleft lip and palate.

The course will introduce the protocols used by well-renowned schools in craniofacial surgery from Taiwan and Brazil. Highly skilled, world-renowned experts in VPD and cleft lip and palate will share their expertise with course attendants, and participate in discussion sessions and panels covering a wide range of clinical cases.

Content will be provided through live surgeries, conferences, seminars, discussions and audiovisual presentations. Technical details for diagnostic and therapeutic procedures will include pictures and videos as support material. An optional speech prostheses workshop will be held on the 1st day, for a limited number of participants only.

After finishing the course, participants will be able to establish a VPD prevention – diagnosis – treatment plan in cleft patients, from a interdisciplinary point of view.


