SUPPORT FOR UKRAINE

SPECIFIC ACTIONS IN ASSISTING UKRAINE OMFS:

Following our statement of solidarity EACMFS will take the following actions to support our Ukrainian colleagues.

EACMFS will waive all the subscription fees for 2022. This measure applies to all categories of membership.

EACMFS will support all Ukrainian colleagues that might apply for travelling scholarship by covering the full cost of the scholarship for a period up to 3 months.

EACMFS will waive any incurring congress fees for the Ukrainian colleagues that will join the EACMFS scientific activities. This measure applies to all categories of membership.

EACMFS is fully aware of the humanitarian crisis taking place right now at the heart of Europe therefore has decided to donate with immediate effect 10,000 euros with the support of the EACMFS Foundation in medical equipment and instrumentation.

We are in direct touch with the EACMFS Councillor for Ukraine and many colleagues in the area and EACMFS acts as a "coordinating" institution to link colleagues in Ukraine with the potential offers of our members. We are also in touch with UEMS/OMFS Section and Board in order to coordinate efforts.

As such there is an offer from the University Hospital in Bratislava (Dr L Czako) of 3 free scholarships for trainees from Ukraine covering accommodation.

In addition, our Lithuanian member, Dr S Grybauskas, is willing to provide links to Maxillo-facial Surgeons in Ukraine (among his contact on the Ukrainian side; Miron Yhryn) in order to assist with material donations by our members.
