




Incheon, a City Representing Korea

EAST TOWER 2F FOOR PLAN







Lotte World Tower



Gyeongbokgung Palace

Gyeongbokgung Palace was the first royal palace built during the Joseon Dynasty and it served as the main palace during the time. It is arguably the most beautiful and remains the largest of all five palaces in Seoul.

Changdeokgung Palace

A UNESCO World Heritage Site the most well-preserved palace of all the royal palaces from the Joseon Dynasty. This is where kings and their ministers discussed state affairs to effectively reign over the people, and where the royal family resided





Deoksugung Palace

Deoksugung Palace is the smallest of Seoul's palaces. It is also the only palace that has two palaces in one and a Western-style garden. Joseon palace architecture and a Westernstyle palace complex, complete with two imposing neoclassical structures.



Hansik, refers to traditional Korean food, centered on rice, served alongside a bowl of soup and a variety of side dishes. Most dishes use meat and vegetables as the main ingredients and are boiled or steamed in brine or water rather than fried in oil. More than anything else, hansik's most outstanding feature is the amount of fermented foods. The most well-known are kimchi (fermented cabbage), ganjang (soy sauce), doenjang (soybean paste) and gochujang (Korean chili paste).
