Programme Description

Upon completion of the Programme, the participants will receive a Certificate issued by EACMFS. Furthermore, an application for the online learning course will be made to the UEMS EACCME® for CME accreditation.

Objectives of the Programme

This Programme aims to:

- deepen participants' understanding of facial anatomy, including the nuances of facial structures
- teach the aesthetic principles necessary to achieve natural and harmonious results, emphasizing the importance of individualized patient assessments and tailored surgical plans
- refine participants' surgical skills, enabling them to perform facial reconstructive and cosmetic procedures with greater precision and confidence.

Programme Curriculum

1. Hands-On Workshop on Human Anatomical Specimens

(25-26 October 2024, at the Centre for Anatomy, Medical University of Vienna)

This hands-on workshop on fresh frozen human anatomical specimens provides a comprehensive overview of reconstructive and cosmetic surgery techniques, with each session beginning with an introduction and then progressing to a hands-on demonstration. Under the guidance of experienced surgeons, participants will have the opportunity to practice the procedures and gain valuable insights, tips, and tricks.

The two-day intensive workshop will be held at the Centre for Anatomy of the Medical University of Vienna, (Währinger Straße 13, 1090, Vienna, Austria) from October 25 to 26, 2024.





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2. Online Learning Course

The Online Learning Course for this Postgraduate Programme is scheduled to run from **November 2024 to June 2025**, with one module scheduled for each month. There will be a total of 7 modules, and each module will consist of two 3-hour webinars.

3. Clinical Observership

The clinical component of the PG Programme consists of a clinical observership for the participants at a specialised unit with experience in facial plastic surgery.

Over the course of two weeks (maybe extended up to four weeks depending on Centre availability), the participant will attend morning meetings, ward rounds, operating theatres and observe facial reconstructive and/ or cosmetic procedures.

Assessment

After completing the Online Learning Course, the participants will be evaluated through an online written examination, which consists of multiple-choice questions.

Requirements for Enrollment and Applicant Selection

Applicants are required to have the following credentials:

- Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery residents in their senior year of training or Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery specialists.

The application (please see below under Registration) must be accompanied by a letter of support provided by the Head of the referring Department or Councillor and an up-to-date curriculum vitae. Knowledge of English is required.

A total of 20 applicants will be selected.

EACMFS Certificate and Accreditation

Upon successful completion of the PG Programme, participants will be awarded a Postgraduate Programme Certificate issued by EACMFS. Additionally, an application for CME accreditation for the online learning course and the hands-on workshop on human anatomical specimens will be submitted to UEMS EACCME[®].



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Tuition Fee

A tuition fee of €6,000 must be paid upon acceptance by bank transfer.

The tuition fee covers the cost of the live online course, the hands-on workshop, examination and Certificate. The tuition fee covers also the full access to recorded live online modules for a year; thereafter active membership is necessary. The fee doesn't cover traveling, accommodation and living expenses during both clinical observership and the hands-on workshop.
